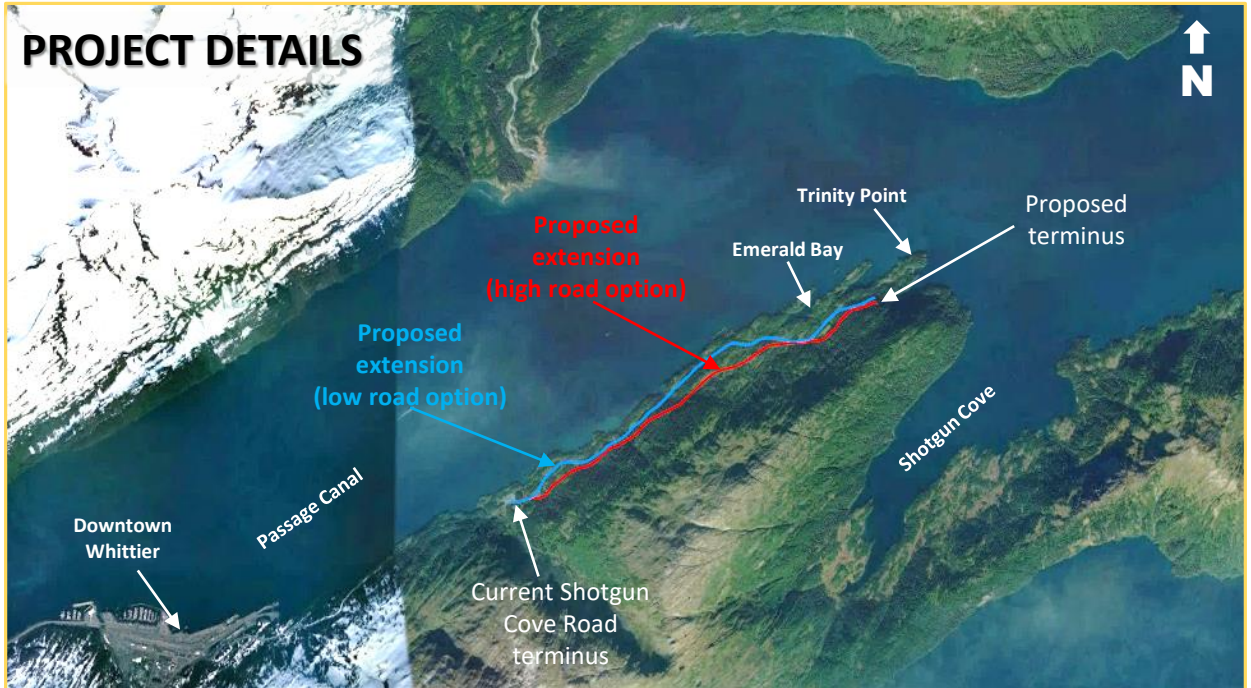


SHOTGUN COVE ROAD EXTENSION

The City of Whittier is starting the conceptual design and environmental planning process to extend Shotgun Cove Road to improve access points to Passage Canal and federal lands for public use and recreation and improved regional transportation.





The proposed Shotgun Cove Road Extension would be constructed for approximately 2.5 miles, parallel to Passage Canal, from the existing Shotgun Cove Road terminus to Trinity Point. The proposed road would be two-lane and gravel. As shown above, a low and a high corridor are being considered.
